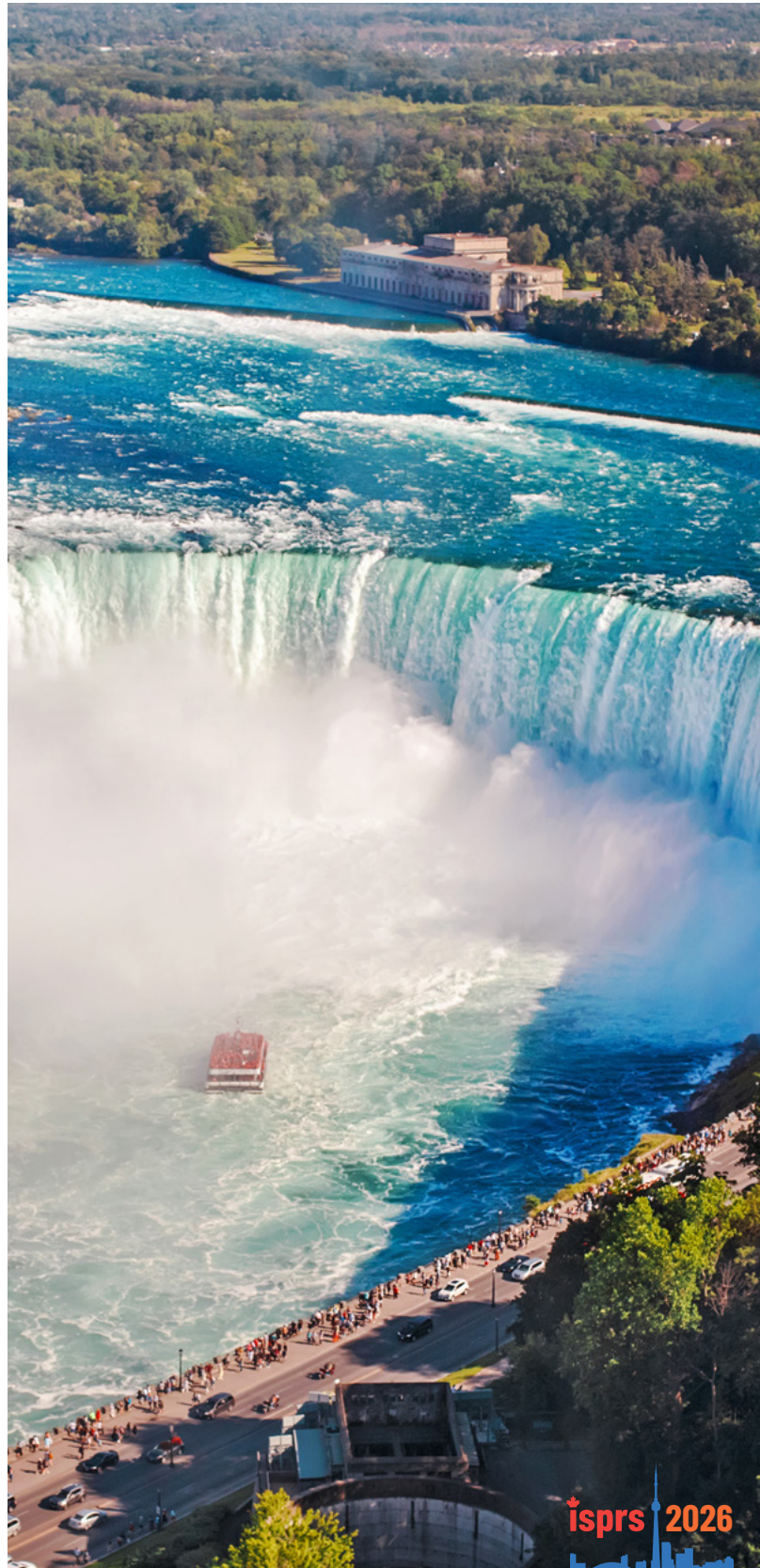

- Geospatial Environment and Health Analytics.

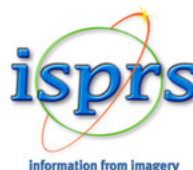

The Canadian Remote Sensing Society—Société canadienne de télédétection (CRSS-SCT) is a fully independent, not-for-profit professional society that provides a focal point for leadership and excellence to advance the remote sensing field. The CRSS-SCT maintains partnerships with other organizations in remote sensing, across Canada and abroad.

The Federal Government's Canada Centre for Remote Sensing (CCRS) was created in 1971 with Dr. Lawrence W. Morley as founder and first Director General. Under Dr. Morley's leadership, the first Canadian Symposium on Remote Sensing was held in February 1972 in Ottawa. CCRS has played a very active role in many aspects of the Canadian Remote Sensing Society ever since.

The CRSS-SCT represents scientists, professionals and students working in remote sensing in Canada and is the Canadian Ordinary Member of the ISPRS. Since 1972 it has organized the world's longest running national series of remote sensing symposia, the Canadian Symposium on Remote Sensing (CSRS). In 2026, the CSRS will be held in parallel with the ISPRS Congress.

The International Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing (ISPRS) is a non-governmental organization that promotes international cooperation between the worldwide organizations with interests in the photogrammetric, remote sensing and spatial information sciences. Established in 1910, the ISPRS is the oldest international professional umbrella organization in its field, which may be summarized as addressing "information from imagery".

The scientific activities of the ISPRS are organized into five Technical Commissions (TCs):

- I. Sensor Systems;
- II. Photogrammetry;
- III. Remote Sensing;
- IV. Spatial Information Sciences; and
- V. Education and Outreach.

Its scientific meetings of various sizes take place over a four-year cycle, culminating with the Congress, the largest international conference devoted to photogrammetry, remote sensing and the spatial information sciences.

ISPRS 2026 Organizing Committee Members

The Congress is being led by individuals and volunteers from the CRSS-SCT. The vision for this Congress is made possible by the willingness to share ideas, information, and the science with which we work across international borders. We look forward celebrating the many achievements of the ISPRS and its members and set the stage for the future as the member organizations of the ISPRS and the fields it represents come together in Toronto in 2026. The information that we develop is critical: our science and technologies underpin much of the world's economic and environmental activities. The story of "imagery to understanding" bears telling – and we plan to work with the rest of the world to tell it in Toronto in 2026.

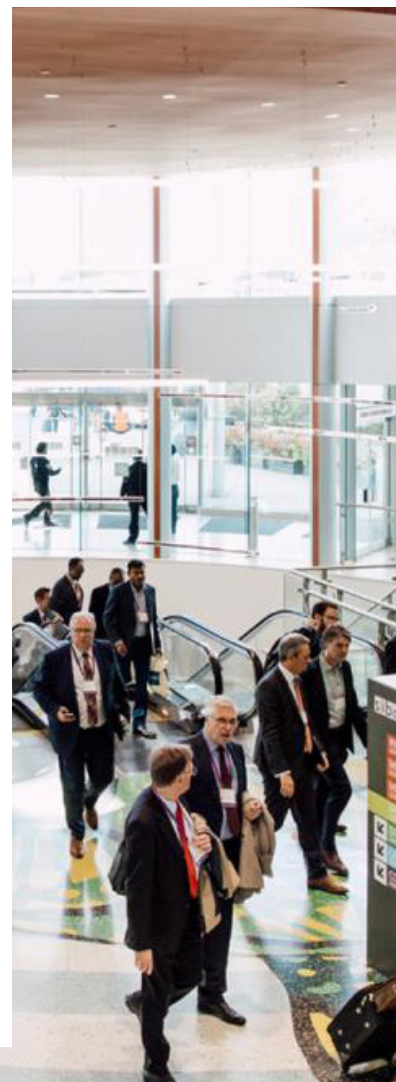

The Venue

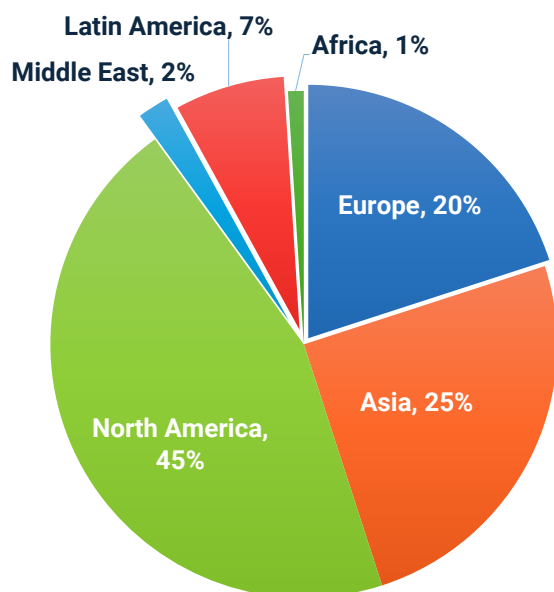

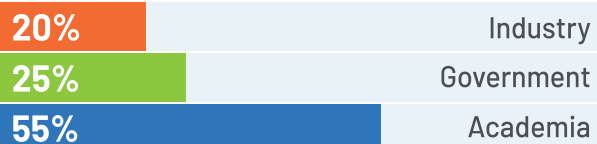

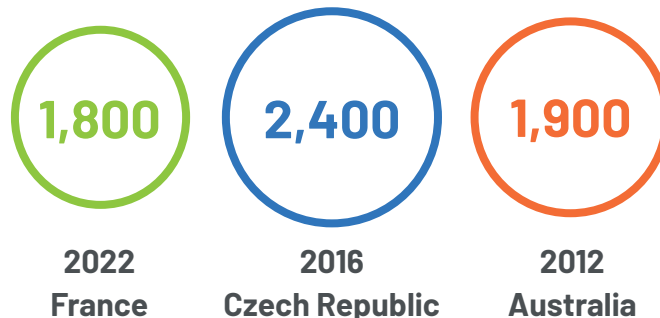

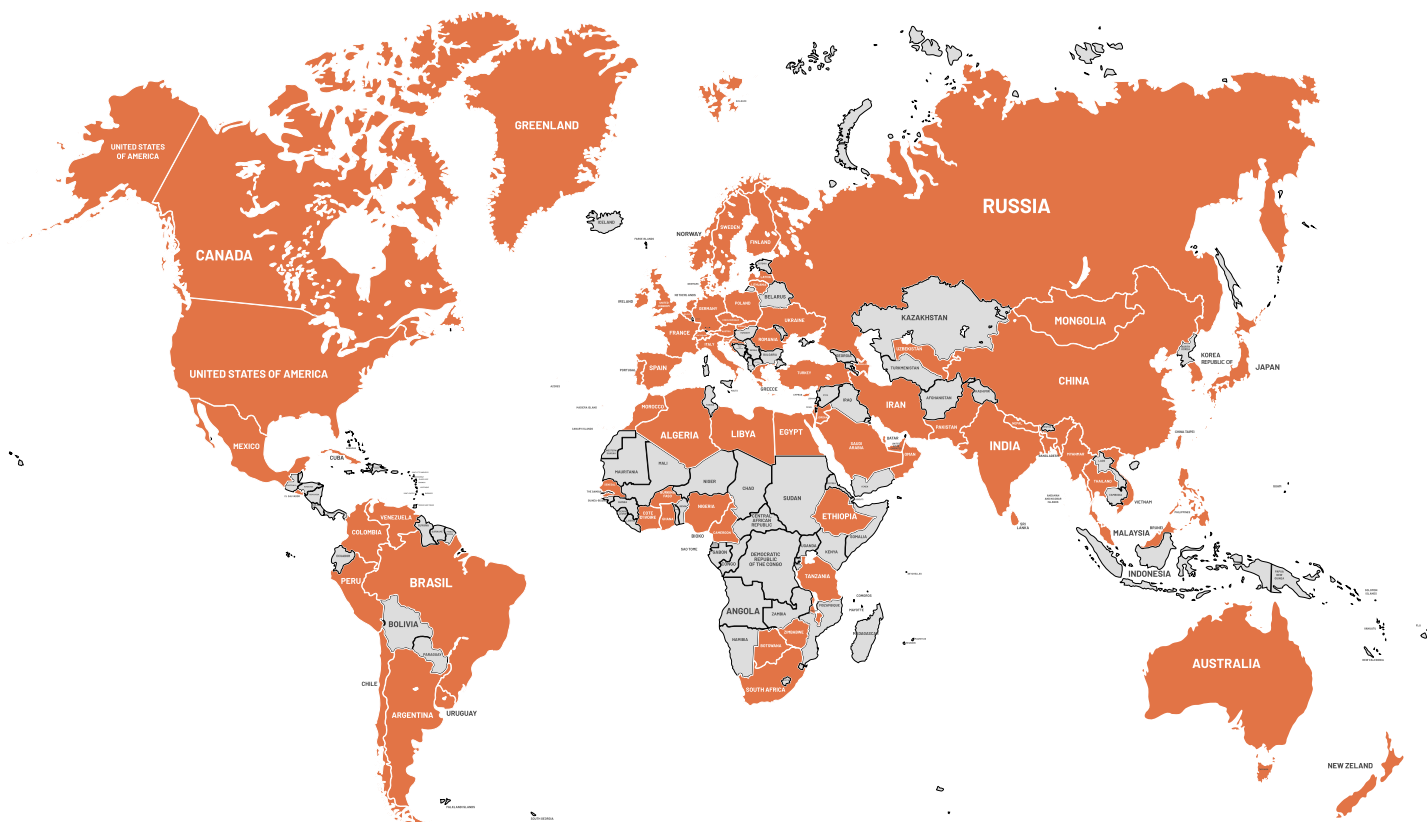
